

Jewish Biblical Holidays and Observances - Leviticus (Vayikra) 23

Weekly

Shabbat - Sabbath - Entering the L.rd's rest.

Springtime (1st Biblical month - Nisan)

Pesach - Passover - Biblical New Year - Salvation.

Messiah Yeshua's substitutionary, sacrificial death for our sins.

Matza - Unleavened Bread - Set free from sin.

Seven days of no yeast. The Messiah Yeshua's sinless life.

Yom Habikkurim - First Fruits - Resurrection

The Messiah Yeshua's resurrection.

Shavot - Pentacost - Assembly of the Congregation of the L.rd.

The L.rd's giving of the Torah and the Holy Spirit

Fall Time (7th Biblical month - Tishri)

Rosh Hashanah - the Jewish Civil New Year - Yeshua to rule and reign.

Blowing of the Shofar. The coronation of kings

Yom Kippur - Day of Atonement – Judgement

The judgement of the Messiah Yeshua

Sukkot - booths - Messiah Yeshua living with us

Building and living in temporary structures for seven days.

Shemini Atzeret - Eight Day Assembly - Celebration of Yeshua

Simchat Torah - Rejoicing in the Torah - Celebration of Yeshua

Other Jewish Holidays and Observances

Tu B'Shevat - New Year for trees - a sign of life (revival) in the lands

Purim - Casting of lots - Defeat of Haman's plot to destroy the Jews

Yom Hashoah - the great slaughter - Holocaust Remembrance Day

Yom HaAtzmaut - Israeli Independence Day

Hannukah - Festival of Dedication and Lights - Commemorates the Maccabean revolt
